- 1. **Rules:** These rules apply to entries into the "**Colgate Spar**" giveaway. By entering the competition, you agree, on behalf of yourself and any person with whom you may share this prize (i.e. spouse, life partner) (if applicable), to be bound by these rules. If you do not agree to these rules, you must not enter the competition. The Promoter reserves the right, acting reasonably, to disqualify entrants who do not comply with these rules.
- 2. **Who may enter:** Any South African citizen or resident, over the age of 18, who is currently residing in South Africa (**"Criteria"**).

The competition is not open to directors, members, partners, employees, agents or consultants of the Promoter, any person who controls or is controlled by the Promoter, or any supplier of goods or services in connection with the competition, or their respective spouses, life partners, business partners or immediate family members.

In the event that the award of the prize under this competition would, in the discretion of the Promoter, result if the contravention of the Promoters policies, the participant shall be disqualified from his/her entitlement and participation in this competition. Should the Promoter, at their discretion, determine that awarding a prize in this competition would violate their policies, the participant will be disqualified from receiving the prize and participating in the competition.

3. **How to enter:**

To enter this competition, the participant must:

- 2. complete the competition entry form, provide consent to receive marketing communication; and
- 3. provide all the information requested as it appears (your till slip number which reflects the **Qualifying Purchase** is required to be eligible to enter the competition); and
- 4. enter during the Competition Period.

("Qualifying Entry")

Qualifying Purchase:

 A Qualifying Purchase to entitle a participant to be entered into the Draw for the Prize a participant must complete a single purchase of four or more Colgate-Palmolive products of the same brand (Colgate, Protext and/or Sta-soft Brands), at a Participating SPAR; or

4. **Draw:**

Prize Draw: All participants who submitted a Prize Qualifying Purchase will be entered into the draw which covers the period in which the entry was submitted and will be randomly selected by the Promoter through the use of a randomised system on the Wednesday following the end of the period which the relevant draw covers. The weekly Provisional Winners will be contacted via direct message via a telephone call, by no later than 7 days after the date on which they were selected pursuant to the draw in which they were selected. The Promoter will attempt to make contact with the Provisional Prize Winners at least three times, but if the Promoter is unable to contact or the Provisional Winner does not respond to the Promoter within 7 days of the third attempt, the Provisional Winner will forfeit his/her prize and the Promoter reserves the right to select a new Provisional Winner.

The Provisional Winners will be required to provide the Promoter with any such information as may be required by the Promoter, including without limitation, certified copies of identity documents and proof of address, in order to verify and assess that the Provisional Winner satisfies the criteria for participation in this competition. Provisional Winners will have 24 hours from the time that they have been notified to submit to the Promoter the required documentation. The Promoter reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to disqualify the Provisional Winners if, based on the information submitted, the Provisional Winners do not satisfy the Criteria or the information submitted is fraudulent or inconsistent with the information previously submitted.

5. <u>Winner Selection:</u> The Promoter, will assess the documents submitted in order to verify the accuracy of the information provided and confirm that the Provisional Winners satisfy the Criteria. Upon satisfaction that the Provisional Winners have provided accurate information and the Provisional Winners satisfy the criteria, the Provisional Winners will be awarded the Prize ("Confirmed Winners").

- 6. **Winner Notification**: The Confirmed Winners will be contacted telephonically by the Promoter within 7 days of selection.
- 7. **Prize:** Each Confirmed Winner for the Prize shall be awarded one R 500 master card voucher. The Prize described above will be provided by the Promoter.

12. <u>Cancellation and amendment</u>: The Promoter reserves the right, acting reasonably, to cancel or amend the competition and draw date due to events or circumstances arising beyond its control which prevent the Promoter from conducting the competition as intended. You are entitled to withdraw from the competition if you do not agree with any amendments made by the Promoter. As far as the law allows, if the Promoter cancels the competition or amends these rules, you will have no claim against the Promoter.

The paragraph above is important. It:

- limits or excludes any rights or remedies entrants may have against the Promoter.

- 14. **No warranties and exclusion of liability:** As far as the law allows, and subject to 17:
 - (i) all warranties and representations in relation to the prize not set out in these rules (whether express, implied or tacit) are hereby excluded;
 - (ii) the Promoter and its associated companies, and their respective directors, officers, employees and agents will not be liable for any loss or damage, whether direct, indirect, consequential or otherwise, arising from any cause which may be suffered as a result of entering the competition, the provision or use of the prize, or any act or omission of any other person.

This clause 14 does not purport to limit or exempt the Promoter for any loss directly or indirectly attributable to their gross negligence or that of any person acting for or controlled by them.
